Communities represented change annually in how many families access the services of RMHC[®] Alberta. Annually RMHC Alberta serves families from **over 300 communities**. This representation does not include the hundreds of families who benefitted from the Day Pass program or the Comfort Cart. Supporting access to pediatric healthcare is essential to families needing to travel.

In 2024 the Ronald McDonald House in Calgary underwent extensive construction to expand its capacity. Through the construction we had to close services for a period of time which impacts the 2024 communities served. We look forward to sharing the tremendous growth in impact as Calgary's Ronald McDonald House opened in May 2025 at **91 suites**, up from the previous 27 family suites.
